Honeywell Defense and Space provides avionics, propulsion, and services for defense and satellite applications, including components and systems that can be applied to commercial and defense applications interchangeably.

Weapons-Related Offerings¹

- Honeywell makes components or systems (primarily inertial measurement units and guidance systems) that are designed, or that undergo certification or other qualification requirements, for use on offensive missiles or munitions, and we also offer corresponding services.
- Revenue attributable to such offerings represented less than 2.0% of Honeywell's 2021 sales, less than 0.4% of which is attributable to offerings used on missiles capable of delivering nuclear payloads and corresponding services.
- Honeywell does not make chemical weapons, biological weapons, anti-personnel landmines, cluster munitions, nuclear warheads, or nuclear missiles.

Federal Solutions Business

- Honeywell's Federal Solutions business manages government-owned, contractor-operated facilities that are part of the U.S. nuclear security complex.
 - Honeywell uses commercial best practices in the management and operation of facilities that are a part of the U.S. nuclear security complex. We ensure that these facilities are operated in a safe and secure manner regardless of the mission they support or the products they produce. Our operating system, which underpins all our facilities both internal to Honeywell and external for customers, ensures the highest level of safety and security to protect people and property.
 - Honeywell does not determine which missions will be performed at these facilities, nor do we own the products, policies, or funding for the mission or the capabilities provided by these facilities.
 - We believe Honeywell's value to the global community is to ensure the safe and secure operation and management of these facilities and the people who are employed at these locations.
- The Federal Solutions business represented approximately 0.3% of Honeywell's 2021 sales.

¹ Excludes components, systems, or services that are (i) used on defensive platforms such as directed energy systems and Iron Dome, (ii) used interchangeably on commercial applications or available through distributors or on the open market, or (iii) used on military aircraft, ships, or land-based vehicles.
